A PRIVATE SERVICE WILL BE HELD FOR MR. SMITH.

BY LAW, AND BECAUSE OF THE CORONAVIRUS, ONLY TEN (10) PEOPLE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CHAPEL FOR THE SERVICE. "BY LAW, BURIAL AND GRAVESIDE SERVICES WILL BE LIMITED TO NO MORE THAN GROUPS OF TEN (10) PEOPLE IN ALL CEMETERIES. ADDITIONALLY, IN AN EFFORT TO ADHERE TO THE CDC'S RECOMMENDED PREVENTATIVE ACTIONS, ALL SERVICES HELD IN CEMETERIES WILL BE HELD WITHOUT CHAIRS UNLESS REQUESTED BY THE FAMILIES, AND BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE GOVERNOR'S ORDER. Alonzo Smith Jr. was born September 28, 1960 to Alonzo Sr. and Norma Jean Smith in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. His father preceded him in death.

Alonzo graduated from John Marshall High School Class of 1978. After graduation he attended the University of Maryland and Camden University. Upon moving to Dallas, Texas area he took courses at Brookhaven and Collin County Colleges.

Alonzo joined the Army October 10, 1978, where he completed the 13th Support Command (CORPS) Advance Leadership Program. He received an Honorable Discharge from the Army where he rose to the rank of Sergeant.

Alonzo was married to Maxcine L. Hislop. To this union, one son was born, Maxwell Alonzo Robert Smith.

After his discharge from the Army, Alonzo became employed with Electronic Data Systems, in Plano, Texas, where he worked as a Computer Engineer of Cyber Security for 29 years.

Alonzo Jr. enjoyed playing the piano, the drums, and playing Chess. He formed "The Chess Club of Allen", which competes with the best Chess Players in North Texas.

On February 2, 2020, he was given the plan of salvation by his daughter Andreia, and he accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Savior. He began a new life in Christ. Oh! What JOY!!!

Alonzo transitioned this life to get his reward on Tuesday, March 24, 2020, at the Baylor Scott and White Heart Hospital of Plano, Texas.

He leaves to cherish his memory: His wife, Maxcine L. Hislop; daughter,

Andreia JeaneFaye Smith; son, Maxwell Alonzo Robert Smith; mother, Norma Jean Smith; two sisters, Lisa Smith Jack (Clint) and Janice Smith, along with other relatives, family and friends.

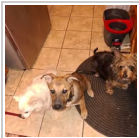
