Billy Wayne Brown was born on July 21, 1950 to Ms. Ruby Dell Hall and Mr. Artis C. Brown in Idabel, Oklahoma. He was also raised by his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Walter Hall.

Billy attended Slater/BTW School, where he graduated in the Class of 1968. He played football and earned the name "Captain Brown".

Billy loved to sing, play dominoes, and hang with his family. He joined Plainview Baptist Church in Idabel, OK at an early age.

In 1969, he moved to Oklahoma City, where he worked for The City of Oklahoma City Water Department. In 1975, he met Linda Scales and in 1977 they were married. 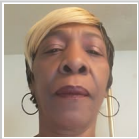
