Carol had a street ministry that her children helped with by singing, praying and handing out sandwiches. She was a part of Reaching out by Faith, Faith miracle circle on KTLV 1220 AM and the Gospel Group call Called The Miracle Messenger, and preaching with Bishop Brown with Holy Everlasting.
