Chris Donell Holloway was born to Maurice and Sandra Holloway on December 9, 1969, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. He was the first-born to his parents. He was also the first-born grandchild to both his paternal grandparents (Samuel and Myrtle Holloway) and maternal grandparents (Shedrick and Beatrice Mimms)

Chris was baptized at an early age by Pastor John A. Reed Jr., at Fairview Baptist Church. As a youth, he attended Sunday school and was a member of the youth ushers. He was also a member of the Fairview Falcon's softball team, coached by Bro. Bob Simmons.

Chris attended Villa Teresa Catholic from the age of 3 through the third grade. It was there that he became an outstanding swimmer. The remainder of his primary and secondary education years were spent in the Millwood school system. Chris was active in various organizations: Boy Scouts of America, Kudos (sponsored by the national sorority of Phi Delta Kappa), and the Millwood varsity football team. He graduated from Millwood High School in 1988.

After high school graduation, he attended Rose State College and Langston University. Chris quickly developed his entrepreneurial skills while attending Langston by selling sandwiches and cutting hair. He later attended and graduated from Mid-Del Beauty College. Chris was known for his fresh cuts, unusual sense of humor and compassion. His skill and passion for helping others look their best, became a lifelong career. He

was a professional business man. Even his father had to have an appointment to get his hair cut.

Chris was dedicated to many causes. One of his passions led him to a position at Cedar Ridge Mental Hospital where he served as a Habilitation Specialist for more than three years.

Chris was a faithful member of the Fifth Street Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor A. Byron Coleman, III.

Family and friends were a priority to Chris. His friends were his life. These valued relationships are what kept him motivated. He called the regularly scheduled gathering of his friends "male bonding". They would share music and sit and talk all night. Chris was distinguished in the group as the bearer of wisdom.

Chris met Angela Hickman in the year 2010 and they became best friends. He proposed to Angela on Valentine's Day 2016. The couple was planning a February 4th wedding.

He was preceded in death by his father, Maurice Holloway.
