September 5, 1956 - July 31, 2017

Daryl Scott was born, September 5, 1956, the second oldest child of six, to Chester and Virginia Fitz, at a Military Base in Washington.

He attended Lawton Elementary School, Harding Middle School and graduated from N. E. High School in 1974. At Northeast he played football, was a member of the Vikings Singers and was active in drama. He had a major role, and did a phenomenal job as King Herod in the play "Jesus Christ Super Star". After graduating, Daryl chose the occupation of his father and attended Metro Tech where he received certification as a chef. Daryl was an awesome cook and he had the opportunity to work as an apprentice at Pearls restaurant, and other fine restaurants. His specialty, and enjoyment was preparing Cajun meals.

Daryl changed his lifestyle and career and began to volunteer at The Kelley Street Club where he became the manager for the next ten years. Daryl always had a heart to help others, so he later took classes and became a Certified Peer Recovery Support Specialist. He worked in that capacity for GMO Urban Ministries and New Day Recovery Youth and Family Services, Inc. Daryl was spontaneous, the life of the party, and he never met a stranger. He valued and had a real love for family and his friends.

In May 2002 Daryl professed his hope in Christ and was

baptized at the Greater Mt. Olive Baptist Church. He served as an assistant Sunday School Teacher, a member of the Male Chorus, the Brotherhood, and the Food Ministry.

Daryl met and later married Sheila Lott. They were married for 15 years. They worked side by side at the Kelly Club and with the Recovery Support program until his health failed him.

His Mother, Father and brother Keith Fitz preceded him in death. He leaves to cherish his memories his wife of 15 years Sheila, sister Yvette (Iody), brothers; Bryan (Deborah), Darrin (Philicia), Jason (Chris), Timothy and Michael; sisters-in-law Jackie (William), Vicki (Jeri), brothers-in-law David (Deborah), [eron (Vanessa), children, LaToyia, Chonta, Charles, Chris, Nathanel and Idris; favorite Aunt Billie White and cousin Cheryl Parker, grandchildren, nieces, nephews, relatives and friends.

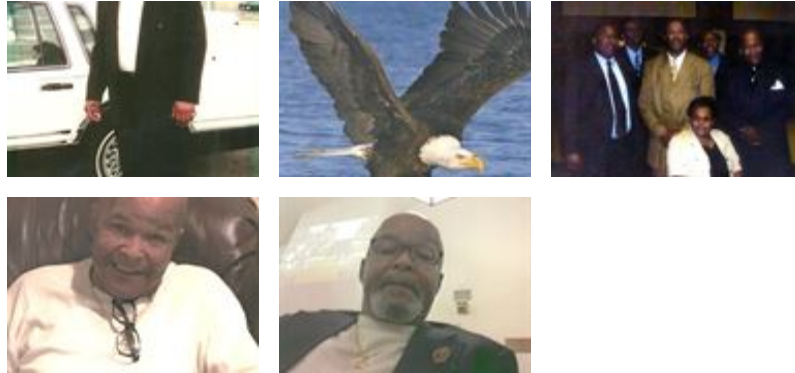
