



Mr Delbert Oguinn

March 27, 1929 - March 21, 2017

Delbert Oguinn's spiritual birth began as the seventh child on March 27, 1929, in Wewoka, Oklahoma. to John and Anna Oguinn. His parents and seven of his brothers and sisters preceded him in death. In May 1947, Delbert graduated from Wewoka High School; he graduated from Langston University in May 1952; and he attended Oklahoma City University from 1957 to 1958. He served in the United States Army from October 24, 1952 to October 2, 1954. In October 1959, he started his career at Tinker Air Force Base. He later transferred to the Federal Aeronautical Administration (FAA) where he retired. Delbert professed his life to Christ at an early age. After his marriage he joined the Fifth Street Missionary Baptist Church, where his wife, Bobbie was already a member. For 58 years he was a dedicated and active member. He served as a Sunday School Superintendent, and for many years as a teacher for the Young People and the Adult Sunday School Classes. As a Christian contribution, he single-handedly started the tape ministry and delivered tapes to the home-bound church members. He also helped to maintain the church building, both inside and out. He became acquainted with most of the people in his neighborhood while walking six days a week to maintain his physical health. After his health would not permit him to walk, some of the neighbors would visit or call to inquire about him. He leaves to cherish his memory his devoted wife, Bobbie Oguinn; one daughter, Sharon Oguinn; one son, Kevin Oguinn (Andrea); two grandchildren, Jaleisa Sheridan and Jason Oguinn; three sisters-in-law; and a host of nieces, nephews, and

other relatives and friends.

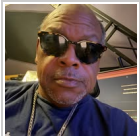
