



Mrs. Della Mae Moore Dukes

August 28, 1931 - August 8, 2019

Della Mae Moore Dukes was born on August 28, 1931, in Milam County Texas, to Jordan and Blumia Allen-Moore. She had four sisters: Mary Onzilee Taylor, Ester Louise Green, and Birma Arstilure Pittmon (all of whom preceded her in death), and Bennie Jewell Nance; and one brother, Rev. Alred Roosevelt Moore, Sr. She was married to the love of her life, Mr. Oscar Dukes, who preceded her in death, and blessed with one son, Alfred Leon Luster; niece, Carol Latrice Runnels, "Chee Chee", (deceased), who was reared as their daughter; and step-daughter Marilyn Dukes (deceased). Her other blessings are her grandchildren: Marnie Dion Luster and Corey Allen Luster, of Oklahoma City, OK. She graduated from Two-Mile Negro School - Gause, TX. She enrolled in Bible Study Fellowship classes and Evangelism courses at the Johnson Memorial Bible Institute at St. John Missionary Baptist Church. She was a Nursing Assistant and retired from St. Anthony Hospital after many years. "Leaving a Legacy: My Life Story by Della Moore Dukes" published in 2012 was one of her biggest accomplishments through Faith. One of the most famous quotes is by the late Eleanor Roosevelt: "You gain strength, courage, and confidence by every experience in which you really stop to look fear in the face. You are able to say to yourself, 'I lived through this horror. I can take the next thing that comes along.' You must do the thing you think you cannot do." Psalms 46:1 reads: "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in the time of trouble." Della was a faithful member of Faith Memorial Baptist Church. She was beloved by many and will be missed by all.

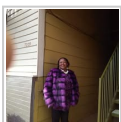
