In the years that followed he worked for Nichols Hills Golf and Country Club, Remington Park, and retired from the University of Oklahoma Faculty House.

GC was a great friend to many and a great father. He was known for the great

love he had for his family. His life was a living example of his motto "Family First." He was the type of person everyone wanted to be around and with his glowing personality and sometimes off-the wall-humor. He would almost always have some sort of riddle or joke to tell when he crossed your path. He was a master of nicknames such as, Ruku, Chrisco, Loc, Sugamama, Monkeygirl, and Pinky, to name a few. If you every sat with him you knew that music, laughter, and love were guaranteed. Some of his favorite musicians were Bob Marley and Jimmy Hendrix. His nickname was "Baby Brother", which came from his favorite song, "Me and Baby Brother," by War.
