The family requests that everyone in attendance wear masks and for those that don't have one, masks will be provided at the service.

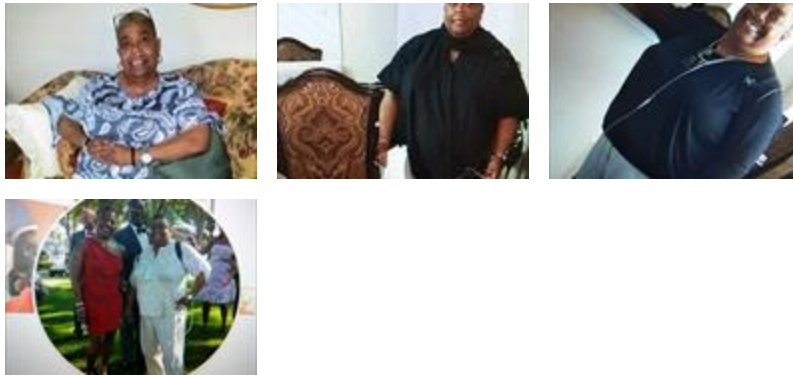

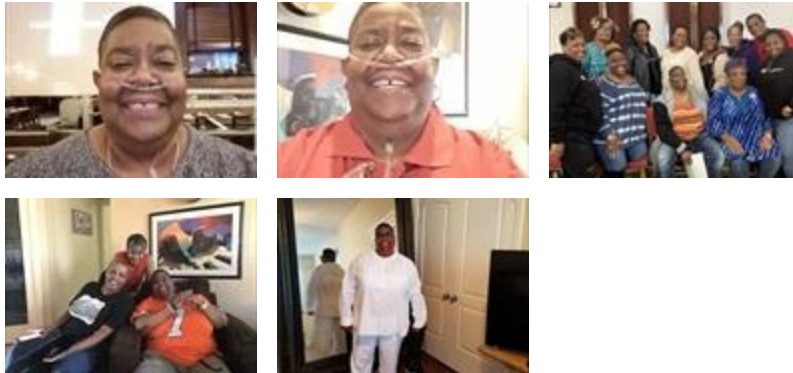
