Dr. Letha Joyce Mosley, Ph.D., OCTA, FOTA, 59, of Conway, Ark departed this life on Saturday, October 7, 2017. She was born November 29, 1957 in Oklahoma City, OK to Rev. Wilbert C. Mosley and Mary Lou Mosley.

She graduated from Star Spencer High School in 1975 and went on to attend the University of Oklahoma and became a Sooner. While attending OU she joined Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., where she remained active. She earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Occupational Therapy in 1980. She later earned her Master of Education degree in Instructional Psychology and Technology in 1993.
