Currently the children continue to reside with me during the week and go and visit their father on most weekends. He also resides in the same county. My question is this. My job is closing its doors in a few months and is moving out west to AZ. I have been offered continuation of my job and living facilities if i consider relocating this fall. I know the children's father will fight me tooth and nail and has the financial means to do so. I do not have money for an attorney. He is self-employed and able to hide his cash income so cries poor and only pays a little over \$600 total for 3 children in child support. Does NC permit a primary custodial parent to relocate if their job is relocating?? I have held this job position for over 6 years. At 49, i am not sure what other job i could get that would pay as well as this one does. Any advice would be helpful and appreciated. Thank you!
