January 10, 1982 - March 26, 2017

Ranord Carvon Robinson was born on January 10, 1982, on a Sunday morning at 12:24 a.m., weighing 8 lbs. 9 1/2 oz., to the proud parents of Ramona Carol (Scott) Robinson and Reginald Wayne Robinson. Ranord was preceded in death by his paternal grandfather, H.S. Robinson; his uncle, Mitchell Robinson; and one cousin, Charles Craig Hill. Ranord accepted Christ at an early age and joined the House of Prayer under the leadership of Rev. Eddie Odell. Ranord's name means "Fame Bright" having a tendency to finish whatever he starts, tolerant, and likes to help humanity, warm-hearted, and gives freely of his time; sympathetic and understanding, having tolerance and acceptance of the frailties of others. Growing up he was an adventurous and happy child. He graduated from Douglass High School. He was a die-hard Trojan -- an avid swimmer on the swim team, an awesome wrestler, great football and baseball player. Ranord excelled in cooking -- he was just gifted to cook. He pursued a trade in culinary arts. He attended Metro Technology Center in Oklahoma City. Later he moved to San Francisco, California, where he attended the Culinary School Treasure Island Job Corps. He received his degree in Culinary Arts and was certified as a Chef. His exam consisted of preparing a meal from scratch explaining the procedure and the presentation had to be perfect. Ranord was assigned a crew who assisted him with the serving of his guests as part of his final exam to include his mother, (Ramona Robinson), grandparents (Joyce and Waymon Swanegan), and cousins (Jackie and Carl Deidrick). He was given the opportunity to work as the chef

at the Harrah Hotel and Casino in Tahoe, Nevada. Ranord moved back to Oklahoma where his career in cooking became successful. He was employed at Remington Park, Metro Technology Center, and Chesapeake Arena, and, at his death, was employed by the Embassy Suites Hotel, all in Oklahoma City, OK. He leaves to cherish his memory his parents, Ramona Carol (Scott) Robinson and Reginald Wayne Robinson, his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Ethel Robinson; one sister, Anai Robinson; five brothers: Reginald (Rayciene) Moore, Richie Robinson, Roland Robinson, Elijah Ruark, and Ray Robinson; one paternal aunt, Gladerie Robinson; one uncle Huey Robinson, Sr.; his maternal grandparents, Joyce (Waymon) Swanegan; his maternal grandparents: Joyce (Waymon) Swanegan; his maternal great-grandmother, Frankie B.
