Roosevelt David Lyons, Sr., was one of ten children born to Jerry and Evelyn Lyons on September 23, 1947, in Hugo, Oklahoma. David completed his elementary and high school education. He joined the United States Marine Corps on February 16, 1967. After serving in the Vietnam War, he was honorably discharged in 1972. He was awarded the Purple Heart after being wounded in service. David was also awarded the Vietnam Service Medal; the Vietnam Campaign Medal; the Combat Action Ribbon; and the Meritous Mast. David met and married Carleen Burleson in Phoenix, AZ. The couple adopted their first son, Kyle, born on September 8, 1979. The second son, David Jr., was born on June 24, 1980. David worked in construction before returning to Independence, KS, to raise his sons until his retirement. David worked as a school janitor and then moved to Oklahoma to be close to his brothers and sister. He leaves to cherish his memory, his sons: Roosevelt David Lyons, Jr., (Amanda), and Kyle Lemont Lyons (Kim); his siblings: Charles Lyons, Willie Lyons, Eugene Lyons, and Margaret Bostick.
