On July 3, 2017, Ruby Johnson completed her life journey ever so peacefully. She was 95 years of age. Ruby Nugent Johnson was born on March 9, 1922, to William (Bill) Roysten Nugent and Sylvia Stevenson, in Springer, Oklahoma. She married Ernest Johnson II in 1944, and was blessed to help rear his two children by a previous marriage. They were: Ernest Johnson III and Vernon V. Douglas, all of which have preceded her in death. She was also preceded in death by a baby sister who died months after birth in 1927. Ruby's mother died in 1929 when Ruby was only seven years old, and her grandmother, who raised Ruby, died in 1948. Ruby had a younger brother, Printes Nugent, who preceded her in death in 1994. Ruby accepted Christ at a very early age and was a faithful member of The Church of Christ throughout her life. Wilshire Church of Christ in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, was her church home. Ruby did not graduate from high school, determined to achieve her GED, she attended night classes and accomplished that goal. She also was a licensed beautician but found her niche in domestic cleaning, a field she would retire from. She was once a school crossing guard and she loved that position because of her interaction with the children. Ruby also devoted her life to helping raise her many nieces, nephews, and a host of foster children. Her grandchildren and great-grandchildren from Ernest III and Vernon gave her much pride, pleasure, and love. In 1962 when Ruby was 40 years old, she and Ernest were blessed with a beautiful daughter who she would call, for the remainder of her life, "Her pride and joy," a baby girl who

she named "Geneva." She cherished and loved "her" Geneva until the last day of her life. She leaves to cherish her memory, Geneva Johnson, her daughter of Oklahoma City, OK; Sister-in-Law of 60 plus years, Vivian Tucker, of Oklahoma City, OK, age 92; a host of grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends, who were far more loved by her than they could ever know.

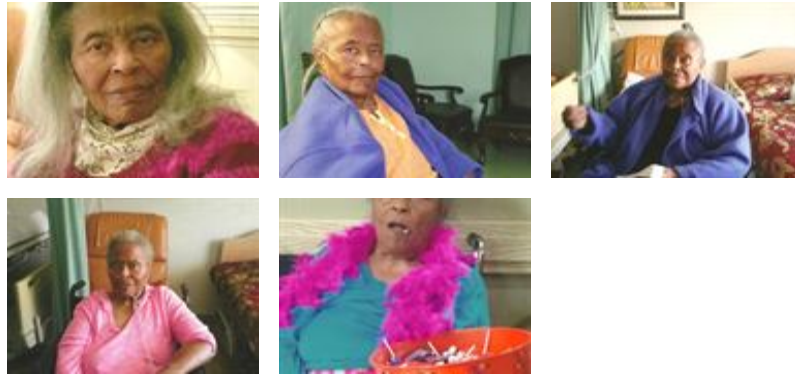
