Terry Lorenzo Caldwell was born in Denver Colorado on 12/1/1966, from the union of Henry and Jacqueline Caldwell. Terry was the firstborn child of this union, and the first grandchild of Salvador and Ruth Owens.

Soon after Terry was born, the family moved back home to Enid, OK, but Terry was very proud he was born in Colorado and was a big fan of the Denver Broncos. Terry was a rambunctious baby and toddler who loved to eat. Jacqueline had to rush to get each spoon of baby food into his mouth to keep him from throwing a fit. When Terry was 4 years old, his sister Jamie was born. The family later moved to Dover where Terry started school. Terry was always very bright and did well in school. He was also always getting into things. He enjoyed attending school with his cousins. The family later moved to Lawton, where Terry completed school through the fifth grade. Terry enjoyed Boy Scouts and hanging around with his friends, going to the neighborhood creek to catch crawdads and playing basketball. The family moved once again, to Clinton, when Terry was in the sixth grade. Terry loved sports in school, but basketball was his favorite sport, learning from his father. Terry was always playing football or basketball in the street, or at the park, with his friends and sister.

Terry earned the nickname "Catfish" in middle school while he was playing sports. Terry also loved to cook and worked at a few local restaurants and did

lawns to earn money. In high school, he was also called Supreme TLC. Terry graduated from Clinton High School in 1985, and attended SWOSU and Redlands Community College. His nickname changed again to T-Loc. Terry moved to OKC and continued to work in restaurants like Olive Garden and Shorty Smalls and Jerry's Deli. Terry also held a CDL and was a driver for All American Waste Management and did some OTR trucking.

Terry later moved to Clinton to help his parents out full time. He cooked for the community breakfast club, He also cooked breakfast for the church every Sunday and catered dinners for several banquets and meetings. Terry was the President of Laymen for the Western District Baptist Association of Baptist Churches. He also served as an Usher at Bethany Baptist, and operated the sound system. Terry held the Office of District Tyler for the 14th Masonic District, Royal Arch Mason, and he was a Heroines of Jericho Knight, and member of the Eastern Stars. Terry was a big supporter of the Clinton Red Tornadoes. He was always saying, "Y'all gone make me lose my mind". Terry was also known for dressing clean as a whistle. He would do anything for his family.

Terry was called from labor to reward Tuesday, July 5, 2022, in the evening, at Mercy Hospital. T-LOC (True Laborers of Christ) was proceeded in death by his mother Jacqueline Caldwell.
