



Mr Theodis Woodson

February 18, 1923 - October 17, 2017

Theodis (Jack) Woodson, loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle and friend made his transition from earth to Glory on October 17, 2017 at his home in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Jack Woodson was born on February 18, 1923 in Rockdale, Tennessee. He was the sixth of twelve children born to Walter Wesley and Ella Stevenson Woodson. He attended Sandy Hook School and after completing the seventh grade was called on to work at several jobs around the home and in the community, eventually working as a machine presser.

In February of 1943 he was called to serve in the US Army as a truck driver and supervised the work of 10 loaders and laborers, all while serving in Normandy, Northern France and Rhineland in World War II. His medals include the American Theater Ribbon, the European African Middle Eastern Ribbon with 3 Bronze Stars, the Good Conduct Medal and the World War II Victory Medal.

Following his honorable discharge from the Army, Jack eventually followed his brothers to Clairton, Pennsylvania where he met and chose for his bride Sara Hardin, exchanging their vows on June 24, 1950.

He was a member of Mount Olive Baptist Church for over 50 years before relocating back to Nashville, Tennessee in 2004 where he was a member of Mount Bethel Missionary Baptist Church and eventually to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma in 2006 where he was first a member of Living Word Missionary Baptist Church before joining Living Water Christian Church, also in Oklahoma

City.

Jack, like his brothers, was a quiet man but loved to travel, tell jokes, and enjoyed being with family and friends.

He was preceded in death by his wife Sara, his father and mother, his brothers, Felix, LD, James, Robert, John, Charles and Leslie, sisters, Lucrita, Ida and Ruby B.

He leaves to cherish his memory one daughter, Patricia Blackburn of Rochester Hills, Michigan; two sons, Larry Woodson of Gaithersburg, Maryland; Greg Woodson (Lisa) of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; one brother, Frank Woodson (Mary) of Nashville, Tennessee; one sister in law, Marion Woodson of Las Vegas, Nevada; seven grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren and a host of nephews, nieces, cousins and friends.
